The two problems with information about academic events

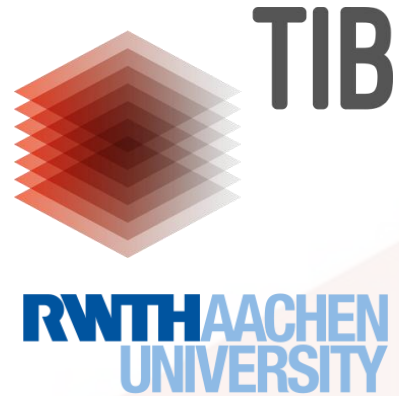
1. Their information is often scattered, unstructured & highly volatile.
