Collection of examples | Photobook

A book whose author - and often also designer - is usually a photographer. Its primary message is determined by the photographs it contains, but it conveys an artistic statement beyond the mere depiction of these photographs, as would be the case in an illustrated book, an exhibition, or on a website. Photobooks can be based on explicitly formulated concepts. The photobook often lacks classic captions and/or explanations, often does without groupings and visual narrative strands, and/or is characterized by innovative graphic design.

A photobook is not a book that you can create from your own digital photos.

Handout for cataloguing

General:

- Description like illustrated book
- Photographer as creator (relationship designator: photographer)
- Consideration of all involved actors (if necessary beyond the standard set of elements),
 regardless of whether named on preferred source of information or not
- All information mentioned in the resource concerning production, etc., is considered (place of production, producer, date of production, circulation, paper used, camera used, etc.)
- Information provided should be recorded in notes (with source of information)

Individual aspects:

- Nature of content: Fotobuch (photobook); if necessary additionally artist book
- Relationships should be established to all agents involved (including relationship designators); it is recommended to link if possible with GND standard records
- Extent of manifestation: exact recording of all counted and uncounted sequences (no estimations)
- Multiple unit: hierarchical description with an analytical description for the parts is recommended
