




## Organisation of D-A-CH

#### **RDA** cooperative project in three countries


























No similar organisational structure for archives and museums in the German-speaking countries!












# Integration of other communities in the organisational environment of RDA as partners

  - Continental, regional and local committees














#### Special Material Working Groups in the German speaking area

#### **Example Literary Archives**

- Cataloguing rules for literary estates and autographs, RNA (Regeln zur Erschließung von Nachlässen und Autographen)
- Descriptive cataloguing: no contradiction to RDA
- No integration of the RNA Rules in the RDA Toolkit
- Cross-references RDA Toolkit and RNA
- Access points according to RDA
- Access points according to GND (Integrated Authority File)






#### RDA and rare or special materials


#### No need for a full integration of special rules in RDA

- Use to describe certain resources with other standards than RDA.
- Use also non-library standards.
- Make alignments from RDA to other standards.
- Build up an organisational structure for all cultural institutions on national and international level.
- Be open to the needs of special communities.
- Collaborate with other communities or groups working about quality of metadata (e.g. Europeana Task Force of Metadata Quality)










