



Implementation Landscape









Adaption to local needs

 You have to look through the standard RDA and work out policy statements and further working documents for your community.





Adaption to Formats and Systems

Come in contact with the system vendors and inform them as soon as possible about the expected modifications for the formats.





Project Management

- Somebody must have an overview.
- Somebody has to make a documentation.
- Somebody has to communicate.
- Somebody must be responsible!

Consortial License for Germany, Austria and Switzerland







RDA Toolkit

- consortial license for all libraries and other cultural institutions in Germany, Austria and Switzerland
- this also applies to institutions from outside D-A-CH with head offices in D-A-CH (e.g. Goethe-Institute)
- does not apply to commercial institutions
- consortium leader and manager is the German National Library



Special Materials

- Bring together experts from the broader community.
- Provide a platform for experts from museums, archives etc.
- Make contacts and create synergies between cultural institutions on an international level.






Training


- Work out a training concept.





- A beta version of the new Toolkit was released on 13, June 2018 in English.
- Final release on 30, April 2019 with the stabilized English text.
- After translations and adaption work in the communities the 3R project will be completed.
- The current Toolkit will remain available for a year after the new Toolkit is fully functional.
