

Concept of the Manual

- The current status of cataloguing in the DACH region is transferred to the manual.
- New concepts are only adopted if they are easy to implement and offer significant added value.
- Documentation as a web application
- Easy and free to use in practical cataloguing



Impacts

- No full German translation further on
- No Policiy Statements in the Toolkit itself, but links between the Toolkit and the manual
- Participation in the content of the Toolkit Community Resources



Consequences

- Elaborated work process
- Great effort that requires many human resources
- Practical cataloguing can be continued without interruption
- The necessary adaptation training will be less elaborate, as the new texts will be drafted on the basis of the existing rules in DACH.



Documentation

- The documentation of the future DACH manual will be carried out in Wikibase.
- A corresponding project was also started in the DNB at the beginning of 2020.
